

Baldwin County is in the process of creating "Forever Records" which will make searching property deeds a whole lot easier! Currently, the project is in Phase One. Records have begun being preserved dating back to 1809.

Phase One includes records from 1809-1934.

This is an important project as some records were not legible. Phase Two of the project will include deeds from 1934-1977 and will eventually be available online.



BALDWIN COUNTY BRATS Goes To The Roadeo

Baldwin Regional Area Transit System (BRATS) bus operators recently completed their required annual training. The rigorous training program includes a written exam, pre-trip inspection evaluation, wheelchair lift operation/wheelchair securement, and driving skills. The two drivers with the highest cumulative score in all four areas of training qualify to participate in the Alabama State Roadeo hosted by ALDOT in Eufaula each year. The State Roadeo winners then advance to the National Roadeo competition hosted by Community Transportation Association of America. The 2022 National Roadeo will be held in Louisville, KY May 13-14. The extensive BRATS driver training program plays an instrumental role in BRATS' excellent safety record and has resulted in BRATS bringing home the national title more times than any other transit agency in the country, with a total of 7 national championships since the competition began 20 years ago.


Two BRATS Drivers Successfully Obtain A Commercial Driver's License!




