Instructions for Voters Applying for an Absentee Ballot

1. Complete and sign the application.

Check the appropriate election: "Primary" and/or "Primary Runoff" (be sure to check your party), or "General Election" on the absentee application. You must fill out a separate application for the General Election in November.

- 2. A copy of your valid photo identification <u>must be</u> submitted along with your absentee application if the reason you are voting absentee requires it.
- 3. Each application for an absentee ballot must be submitted in a separate envelope.
- 4. The deadline to request an absentee ballot or vote absentee inperson is five calendar days before the election.
- 5. The deadline for receiving mailed in applications is seven calendar days before the election.
