

# FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

Baldwin County Commission has applied for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance (PA) Program funding through Alabama Emergency Management (AEM) as a sub-grantee.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), federal actions must be reviewed and evaluated for feasible alternatives and for social, economic, historic, environmental, legal, and safety considerations. Under Executive Order (EO) 11988 and EO 11990, FEMA is required to consider alternatives, and to provide a public notice of any proposed actions in or affecting floodplains or wetlands. EO 12898 also requires FEMA to provide the opportunity for public participation in the planning process and to consider potential impacts to minority and low-income populations. This notice may also fulfill requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

**Special Flood Hazard Area Zone:** This project is for the replacement of building components and structures. All work is located in a VE zone. Confirmation of location in a Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) was determined by the Baldwin County Flood Insurance Rate Map, Panel Number #01003C0870M, dated 04/19/2019. The proposed work conforms to all applicable State of Alabama and local floodplain regulations. There is a potential for the facility to be impacted by future flooding events due to its location. The proposed work will take place in wetlands per the United States Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory.

**Proposed Work and Purpose:**

Perdido Bay Park (30.40008, -87.44816): The Baldwin County Commission plans to remove and replace wood stairs (6 FT long x 6 FT wide x 3 FT high) and wood decking (1,050 SF, 175 FT long x 6 FT wide), guardrails, and stringers on the boardwalk. Cost: \$37,112.21.

**Project Alternatives:**

**Alternative #1** (No action): The 'no action' alternative would ultimately result in a negative impact on Perdido Bay Park Launch. If these repairs are not made, then adverse economic and social impacts may occur. Not repairing the park negatively affects recreational activities within the community.

**Alternative #2** (Complete replacement) The “replacement” alternative would require full replacement of the entire structure with a new and improved structure. This alternative is more costly and economically infeasible relative to the proposed repairs. It would also delay the repairs and leave the park inaccessible for recreational activities. Due to the time and cost of replacement, this alternative is not cost-effective.

**Comment Period:**

Comments are solicited from the public; local, state, or federal agencies, and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of the proposed project. The comments should be made in writing and addressed to Baldwin County Commission. All comments are due within 30 day of this notice. The Baldwin County Commission will forward comments to applicable regulatory agencies as needed.
