## Baldwin County Commission CDBG-DR Capacity Building Work Session

The Baldwin County Commission will host a Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Capacity Building Work Session with municipal and public utility stakeholders on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, at 10:00 AM in the Baldwin County Central Annex Building Auditorium at 22251 Palmer Street Robertsdale, Alabama. The Baldwin County Commission is a subrecipient of CDBG-DR funds from the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs. The purpose of the CDBG-DR Capacity Building Work Session is to provide information to the prospective subaward applicants on the Local Government Recovery Infrastructure Program (LGRIP) in response to Hurricanes Sally and Zeta, which struck in 2020. Under the LGRIP, the County will distribute funds to subrecipients on an award basis via a competitive application submission process. The LGRIP will allocate CDBG-DR funding to subrecipients to implement their awarded projects. Specifically, the work session will cover program requirements, project eligibility, and prioritization considerations for project selection.
