REBUILD ALABAMA ACT AMENDED

- On March 12, 2019, Act 2019-2, also known as the Rebuild Alabama Act, was signed into law by Governor Kay Ivey.
- This Act amends Section 40-12-242, Code of Ala. 1975, to include an additional registration fee of \$200 for each battery electric vehicle and \$100 for each plug-in hybrid electric vehicle operated on the public highways of this state.
- This additional fee is effective beginning on January 1, 2020
